Project: **FIRST FARMERS AND MERCHANTS BANK
Columbia, Tennessee**

A landmark in this growing community, this new three-story, 40,000 square foot facility provides extensive customer banking services, administrative offices, meeting rooms, library archive storage, and work spaces for employees and clients.

A new single-story 4,000 square foot branch bank with new covered drive-thru teller lanes and new parking and site plan.

Based on the growing standardization of the architectural appearance of the bank's expanding branches, this 5,600 square foot, single story structure provides a recognizable, efficient, and pleasing facility.



Project: **COMMUNITY FIRST BANK AND TRUST
Franklin, Tennessee**

A new three-story, 21,000 square foot building provided a new branch location on Carothers Drive. Classical architectural features and materials give the bank branch identity and a timeless appeal.

Project: **CUMBERLAND BANK
Murfreesboro, Tennessee**

Extensive renovations to a stand-alone 3,400 square foot building provided a warm and inviting customer service branch. A new drive-through teller area with new covered canopy were constructed.

Project: **UNION PLANTERS BANK**
Madison, Tennessee

This 3,000 square foot facility was designed as a Prototypical plan that could be utilized throughout the Middle Tennessee area. The facility accommodates seven tellers, four bank officials and support functions such as safe deposit boxes, conference area and lounge.

Architectural features include a unique arch at the entrance that will identify the structure as a Union Planters facility.

The 3,200 square foot Nolensville Road branch is a modified prototype designed to adapt to this unique corner lot. The structure provided an increase in drive-through lanes with master-planning for further expansion.

Hendersonville, Tennessee

The existing Gallatin Road facility was renovated and expanded. The overall appearance was modified in an effort to standardize the various architectural styles that exist throughout the Union Planters Branch system.

The two-story, 30,000 square foot facility provided a new home for the expanding Credit Bureau. The structure included flexible open-office areas as well as executive offices, board room and support functions.

The post-tensioned concrete structure was clad in brick with limestone accents and standing seam metal roof. The three story configuration accommodated covered parking at the basement level.

Project: **DOMINION BANK**
Murfreesboro, Tennessee

The 3,500 square foot facility included three drive-through lanes and provisions for future expansion. The existing structure was heavily modified and included an extensive exterior renovation in addition to new architectural finishes and complete replacement of mechanical, plumbing and electrical components.

Project: **METROPOLITAN FEDERAL SAVINGS BANK**
Nashville, Tennessee

The 8,500 square foot Savings and Loan included approximately 4,000 square feet of leasable office space on the upper level. Due to the limited lot size and restrictive zoning, the structure was heightened in order to maximize the number of parking spaces. The concrete and masonry structure included a high level of interior detail that reflected corporate standards.
