The 46,000 square foot expansion is comprised of a three story, post-tensioned concrete structure with sub-surface parking. The residential quality of the neighborhood required a traditional approach to the architecture of the exterior facade.

The facilities include a 120 seat broadcast-capable lecture hall, diversity institute classrooms, library, general office, and executive office suites.

The two-story, 30,000 square foot facility provided a new home for the expanding Credit Bureau. The structure included flexible open-office areas as well as executive offices, board room and support functions.

The post-tensioned concrete structure was clad in brick with limestone accents and standing seam metal roof. The three story configuration accommodated covered parking at the basement level.

Three stories comprised this 22,000 square foot facility. The ground level included a public lobby, board room, staff lounge, open-office, print shop and executive offices at the perimeter. The second floor was occupied primarily by open-office areas, perimeter executive offices and file storage. The public lobby area is enhanced by a two-story atrium with pedestrian bridge that provides a dramatic entrance while minimizing the impact on useable floor area.

In addition, many of the public areas are finished in marble, stained wood and brass accents to further enhance the recognizable Bradford look.

The structure incorporated a brick veneer with multicolor brick accent. Architectural features included a mansard roof screen of the HVAC equipment with a color coordinated storefront system.

A central atrium with artificial skylight was utilized to enhance the function between retail sales, wholesale sales, warehouse and administration. The existing tilt-up concrete panels were modified to provide an appealing facade to enhance retail sales.
