The single story, 60,000 square foot Phase I structure contains general and open office space, classrooms, data processing center, computer equipment rooms, cafeteria, exercise room and support facilities. The 50,000 square foot, two-story, Phase II building contains primarily of open-office areas, executive offices and public lobby. A 60,000 square foot Phase III Expansion is currently in schematic design.
